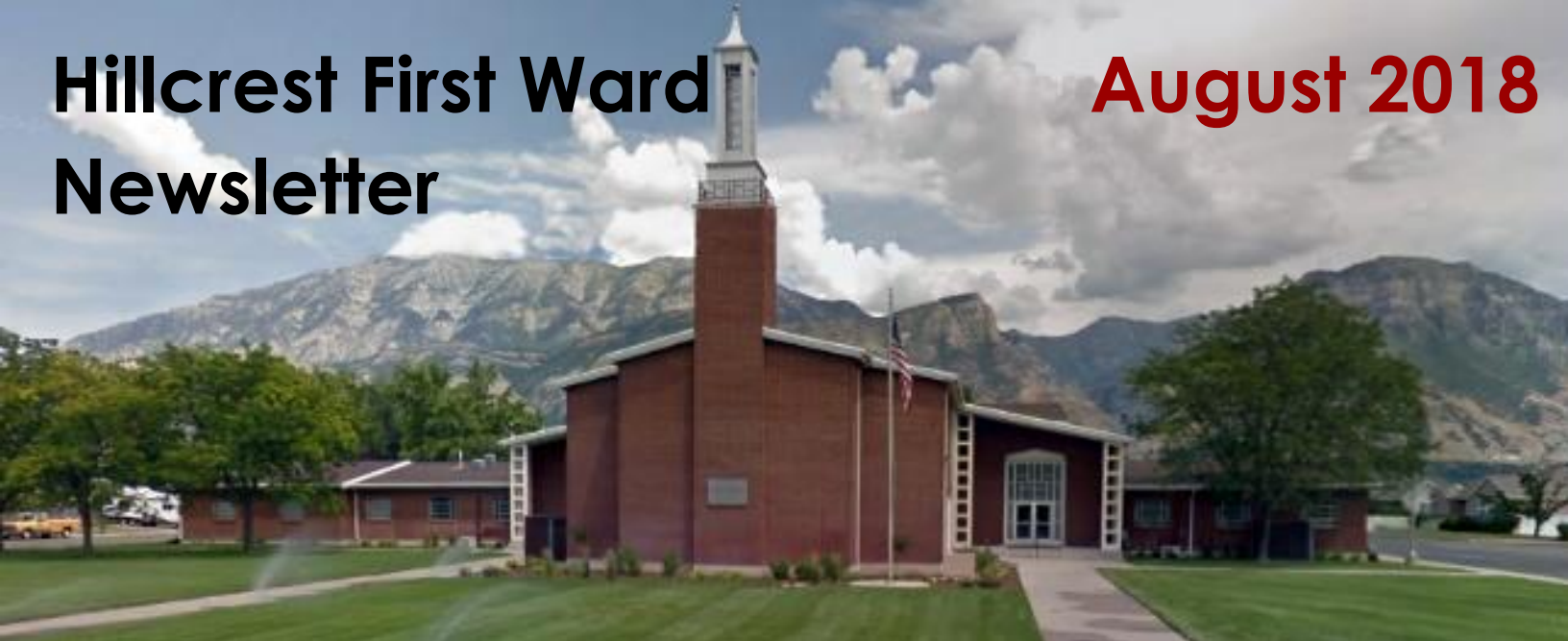

Lots of people rode the zipline and jumped off into the lake, but I think we'd all agree, seeing Bro. Pinkham do it was pretty impressive!

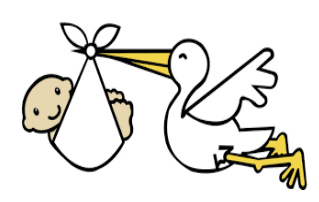
